**PROPERTY TAX EXEMPTIONS**



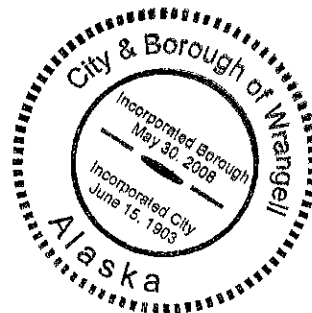


