- **DATE:** July 15, 2016

BACKGROUND

Borough staff issued an invitation to bid for the construction of the Wrangell Barge Ramp Concrete Paving project for which bids were due today, July 15, 2016.

The invitation to bid includes demolition and disposal, excavation, geotextile, shot rock, base course, and concrete paving for replacement of two sections of concrete and gravel runway at the Barge Ramp.

Two bids were received as follows:

- 1. Rainforest Contracting, Petersburg \$179,060.00
- 2. BW Enterprises, Wrangell \$122,091.09

The Harbor Department budgeted \$125,000 of capital funds for this project in the FY2017. Staff recommends entering into a contract with BW Enterprises for construction of the paving work with a construction cost of \$122,091.09.

If approved by the Borough Assembly, staff will issue a Notice of Intent to Award to BW Enterprises in order to allow the Contractor to begin acquiring the required bonds and submittals prior to the start of construction.

RECOMMENDATION

Move to approve a bid award to BW Enterprises for construction of the Wrangell Barge Ramp Concrete Paving project in the amount of \$122,091.06, funded from the Ports and Harbors FY17 Reserves.

To all the foregoing, and including all Bid Schedule and information required of Bidder contained in this Bid Form, said Bidder further agrees to complete the WORK required under the Contract Documents within the Contract Time stipulated in said Contract Documents, and to accept in full payment therefor the Contract Price based on the total bid price(s) named in the aforementioned Bid Schedule.
