Failure to register may adversely affect your proposal. It is the Offeror's responsibility to ensure that they have received all Addenda affecting this Solicitation. FIRM OFFER. For the purpose of award, offers made in accordance with this RFP must be held firm for a period of fifteen (15) calendar days from the date of the Receipt of RFPs.

REJECTION OF PROPOSAL. The City & Borough of Wrangell (Wrangell) reserves the right to reject any and all proposals and to waive any informality or irregularity in the proposals received whenever such rejection or waiver is in the best interest of Wrangell. The City and Borough of Wrangell reserves the right to modify the contract after its award.

QUALITY OF WORK. All materials shall conform to the specifications, industry standards and practices, and the manufacturer's requirements.

IMMATERIAL DIFFERENCES. The City & Borough of Wrangell reserves the right to determine whether equipment that complies substantially in quality and performance with the specifications are acceptable, and whether any variance listed by the Proposer is material or immaterial.

### EVALUATION OF PROPOSALS AND SELECTION AND AWARD

1. Successful Proposer will be determined by the Evaluation Ranking as indicated in

Part 3 of the solicitation. Awards will not be made based on price alone. The City & Borough of Wrangell reserves the right to arrange for discussions and demonstrations to assist in the evaluation of proposals. Award will be made to the responsive and responsible Proposer whose Proposal is determined to be most advantageous to the City & Borough of Wrangell.

- 2. The Criteria and Evaluation Form is listed under Part 2 of this solicitation. In the Proposal, under Column 2 of this form, the Proposer shall respond to each minimum requirement listed in Column 1, Technical Specifications (Minimum). If necessary, a separate sheet may be used for description. When asked to "describe", the description may include details such as size, capacities, dimensions, materials used in construction, etc. A full and complete description is required to reasonably evaluate the Proposal, so all pertinent information is required. When referring to attached literature as a means of not fully describing items, misinterpretations by the evaluator of the Proposal may occur and consequently not having the Proposal awarded.
- 3. Proposer's ability to present the City & Borough of Wrangell with enough information to reasonably understand the item being Proposal, and whether or not it meets the specifications stated, relies on the written information provided. AWARD OF CONTRACT AND AGREEMENT. #### PART 3.5 SCORING AND RANKING METHODOLOGY.

Committee members will score responses independently:

- A. Points:
  - 1. Members will assign point to each Proposer, 0 through 5 (5 being the highest score), for each criteria. Points may be assigned as whole numbers or fractions, i.e. 1.0, 1.7, 3.75, 4.5, etc.
  - 2. Members points for each evaluation criteria will be multiplied by the criteria weight resulting in a total score. The total score obtainable is 500.
- B. Scores:
  - 1. Members' evaluation criteria scores for each Proposer will be added together for a total score and final ranking.
  - 2. The highest total score will receive a ranking of 1; the 2nd highest total score will receive a ranking of 2, and so on.
- C. The Members will meet to discuss the responses, scoring, and any other issues related to the project. Members have an option to either:
  - 1. Adjust their scoring based on their discussion;
  - 2. Re-rank respondents based on their discussion; or
  - 3. Determine a scoring by the consensus of the Members.
- D. The Members may prepare a "shortlist" of highest scored Proposer's depending on the number of Proposers and analysis of the final scoring.

#### PART 3.6 DISCUSSION AND DEMONSTRATIONS

A. After reviewing submissions, the Borough may request discussion or interviews with either the short listed or top ranked Proposer(s) to further clarify the Borough's requirements, the Proposer's response and/or request additional information. Therefore, the Proposer shall have officials of the appropriate management level present and representing the firm, if a presentation is scheduled by the Borough. All costs associated with the presentation shall be borne by the Proposer.

B. All equipment included in the Proposal is subject to a performance demonstration at the discretion of the Borough, within 15 days of the Proposal date. A like item of the type Proposal that contains all the safety concerns, performance criteria, accessories, dimensions or other features as deemed appropriate by the City & Borough of Wrangell may be required to be demonstrated to Borough personnel prior to award of the Proposal in order to establish that the item meets the requirements and specifications. These demonstrations may be held in direct competition with other vendors who Proposal the same or similar equipment. All costs associated with the Proposer's demonstration shall be borne by the Proposer. All travel costs by Borough personnel shall be borne by the Borough.
