Who is Eligible?

P2P is open to individuals, for-profit businesses or tribal entities. Business ideas may include a new business or an expansion of an existing business. Applicants must be southeast Alaska residents.

Winners

Twelve semi-finalists will receive a scholarship from UAS School of Management, attend a weekend boot camp in Juneau, and receive technical assistance in writing a business plan. Three business plans will be selected as finalists and each will receive an award of up to \$40,000 for consulting and technical services to develop the business.
