# **CITY COLLECTED SALES TAX**

Current sales tax levied on all goods and services is 7%. Sales Tax is collected quarterly. Sales tax receipts are used for the following purposes:

68% into the general fund 28% to schools, health and sanitation 4% to roads and streets

### **ANNUAL EMPLOYMENT AND PAYROLL**

Prior to 1995, Alaska Pulp Corporation represented approximately 30% of the wage earnings and 20% of jobs within Wrangell (225 direct jobs). The annual employee earning figures obtained from the state show a loss of \$9 million in employee earnings between 1994 and 1995. Likewise, annual number of employed persons in Wrangell showed a 20% decrease from 12,672 to 9908. Wrangell's manufacturing component of the economy dropped from 28.5% to 12.5%. Since the mid 1990's, Wrangell as made every effort to diversify its economy by enhancing infrastructure for tourism and the marine industries.

The following tables show the growth in *annual* employment figures and payroll (sum of number jobs worked each month, and sum of payroll figures each month) for Wrangell since 1990. The Wrangell sawmill closed mid December 1994. The city saw growth in home occupation permit approvals during the late 1990's and early 2000's, mostly for individuals seeking to supplement incomes. *The Alaska Department of Labor does not include commercial fishermen in its employment count, nor self-employed individuals.*
