RESTRICTIONS AND REQUIREMENTS

COPYRIGHT DISCLAIMER:

The Wrangell Museum photographs are obtained from many sources and are intended primarily for research and educational purposes. Certain works may be protected by copyright or trademark. Permission will be granted only to the extent of The Wrangell Museum’s ownership of the right relating to your particular request. **The responsibility for ascertaining whether any such rights exist, and for obtaining all necessary permissions remains with you, the applicant.** The Wrangell Museum retains the sole copyright for its holdings and all images depicting its holdings. Photographic images that are in care of, or are the property of The Wrangell Museum, or photographs, photocopies, or artistic renderings of collection items that are in the care of, or are the property of The Wrangell Museum, shall not be reproduced, resold or commercially used without the written permission of The Wrangell Museum. The Copyright law of the United States of America (Title 17, US Code) governs the making of photocopies or other reproductions of copyrighted material. Under certain conditions specified in the law, libraries and archives are authorized to furnish a photocopy or other reproduction. One of these specified conditions is that the photocopy or reproduction is not to be “used for any purpose other than private study, scholarship or research”.

PERMISSIONS:

All permissions are issued for ONE TIME USE in one publication, one edition and one language. Approval for an item’s reproduction must be granted in writing by the Director of The Wrangell Museum. Subsequent use of these photographs is prohibited without additional written permission by the Director.. The reproductions and their contents will not be further reproduced or published in part or in full, sold or given to another person, or made available to another person or institution without written approval from The Wrangell Museum. Downloading an image from the website in no way transfers either copyright or property right, and does not constitute permission to publish or display in excess of fair use. Any permission granted is within the sole discretion of the Director and such permission may be revoked at anytime in the discretion of the Director.

PAYMENT and FEES:

Permission to reproduce museum materials is contingent upon payment of fees and the photographs will not be useable until payment in full is received Please make checks payable to “The Wrangell Museum” and note “For Photo Reproduction”. The Museum assumes no responsibility for any royalties or fees claimed by the artist or photographer, or on his or her behalf.

CREDIT:

Full credit must appear in immediate proximity to the reproduction or in the section within the publication devoted to acknowledgements. In the case of motion picture publications, visual credit must appear at the beginning or at the end.

RESTRICTIONS and LIMITATIONS:

These photographs shall not be used to show or imply The Wrangell Museum endorsement of any commercial product or enterprise, or to indicate that The Wrangell Museum concurs with the opinion expressed in, or confirms the accuracy of any text used with these photographs. The Museum may refuse permission to reproduce images if the reproduction does not meet Museum standards or if their use would be detrimental to the collection of the reputation of The Wrangell Museum. If so requested, a proof must be approved by The Wrangell Museum before the reproduction of an image.

COPY OF PUBLICATION:

As part of the agreement to grant reproduction permission, The Wrangell Museum requires that immediately upon publication, one copy of the publication in which The Wrangell Museum have been used be furnished at no cost to The Wrangell Museum for use in our Library & Archives files. If the images are to be used for exhibit purposes photos in situ are requested. No new photo orders or permission requests submitted by the individual, organization, production company or distributor will be processed if this copy has not been received by The Wrangell Museum within three months of the stated release date.

I understand that I am obligated under law (Title 17, US Code), not to use these materials or permit the materials to be used for any further reproduction without the express written permission of the copyright owners. I assume all copyright responsibility for the items listed and I agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless The Wrangell Museum and the City and Borough of Wrangell and their Assembly members, board members, officers, agents, representatives and employees from any actions and damages of any kind, including attorneys fees and costs, brought by or on behalf of the copyright owners alleging any misuse of such materials. In any court action instituted by the Wrangell Museum or the City and Borough of Wrangell to enforce any provision of this Licensing Agreement, I agree that any such action shall be brought in the First Judicial District at Wrangell, Alaska
