JOB TITLE: PARK/CEMETERY MAINTENANCE II

REPORTS TO: Park/Cemetery Maintenance I

DEPARTMENT: Parks and Recreation Department

JOB PURPOSE: To perform a variety of unskilled and semi-skilled

work in mowing, weedeating, landscaping, grounds maintenance, repairing, preparing, installing, and construction of parks, playgrounds, ball fields,

cemeteries, and facilities.

DUTIES. RESPONSIBILITIES AND ACCOUNTABILITIES:

 Constructs, repairs, places and installs signs, benches, tables, fences and bases. Assists in park maintenance work involving the placement, repair, painting and maintenance of buildings and structures.

- Mows all park and cemetery lawns and turfs. Prunes trees and shrubs, slashes brush, removes cuttings and litter from parks, cemeteries and city grounds.
- Participates in landscaping by preparing ground, planting, transplanting, fertilizing, trimming and pruning.
- 4. Operates light trucks and small tractors and other powered equipment such as rota-tillers, chain saws, weed eaters, and lawn mowers.
- Cleans park shelters, fire pits and grounds. Cleans and disinfects park restroom facilities.
- 6. Maintains all records and reports as required.
- Ensures that all supportive services, such as water, electricity, etc., are available when needed at recreational sites.
- Assists in excavation and backfilling of burial sites.
- Assists other departments and agencies as needed, and other duties as assigned.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS AND ABILITIES:

- Requires the ability to follow written and oral instructions.
- Requires the ability to load and unload 60 pound sacks of materials with assistance.
- Requires the ability to safely operate power tools and equipment.

MINIMUM QUALIFICATIONS:

Must be at least 18 years of age and possess an Alaska Drivers License.
